## Directions to Tucker Farms and the Great Adirondack Corn Maze

112 Hobart Road, Gabriels, NY

### From the North (Malone):

Take Rte 30 south (approx 33 miles) to Paul Smith's College. Turn left onto Rte 86. Drive south to Gabriels. Turn right at Hobart Road and Tucker Farms sign.

### From the South (Lake Placid):

Use Exit 30 off I-87, following Rte 73 north to Lake Placid. Stay left after the ski jump facility onto Old Military Road for 3.6 miles. Turn left at Rte 86 and follow to Gabriels. Turn left on Hobart Road and Tucker Farms sign.

### From the East (Plattsburgh):

Use Exit 38 off I-87, following Rte 374 to Rte 3 for 8 miles. Follow Rte 3 to Bloomingdale for 35 miles - turning right at Norman's Store in Bloomingdale to Rte 86 for 4 miles. Turn right onto Rte 86 and continue for about 1/2 mile toward Gabriels. Turn left at Hobart Road and the Tucker Farms sign.

### From the West (Tupper Lake):

Follow Rte 3 east approximately 20 miles to Saranac Lake. Turn left on Rte 86 in the center of the village. Drive north approx. 8 miles to Gabriels. Turn left at Hobart Road and the Tucker Farms sign.

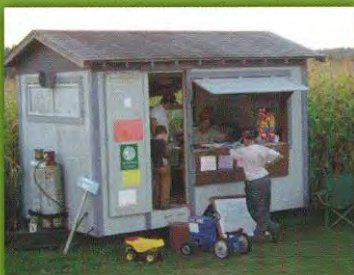
