


ART IS EVERYWHERE IN SARANAC LAKE

Centered around the baseball field, turned skating rink in the winter, you will find a sawmill, ice cream stand, record shop, fire department, brew pub, antique stores, several churches, a couple auto mechanics, and, of course, a Dollar General. Life in Bloomingdale moves at a slower pace and will remind you of days gone by, memorialized by the work of Norman Rockwell.

PAUL SMITHS

Home of the "College of the Adirondacks" and the prestigious St. Regis Chain of Lakes, you can find people living in places like "Easy St," Keese Mills and McColloms. They all share pride in the hotdog vendor, who can usually be found midday at the intersection of State Routes 86 and 30.

TOWN OF FRANKLIN

Still wholly within the Saranac Lake School District, the hamlets of Vermontville, Sugarbush, Loon Lake, and Onchiota are in this vast township. Merrillsville, Thatcherville, Goldsmith, Alder Brook, Union and Franklin Falls and Kushaqua Lake represent the smaller, older settlements. Although always willing to lend a hand, the thing that residents in this town have in common is they want room to spread out... and only entertain neighbors if they are invited.

GABRIELS

On the edge of the scenic farm fields, just past Donnelly's Ice Cream, you can find 205 of the nicest people. The post office, handy mini mart and sprawling athletic field are defining features. Locals still lament the loss of "Teddy's Mall" which "Had it all."

RAINBOW LAKE

Bisected by a historic railroad bed, a residential neighborhood can be found buffering this gorgeous waterbody. Known for its tall pine trees and unique topographical features, you can also find a thriving maple syrup operation, potato fields, and a children's camp tucked into the woods.

LAKE CLEAR
